RE: UCMS STUDENTS' UNION: MINUTES OF STAKE-HOLDER MEETINGS (pp.1&2)

Four meetings of the stakeholders, drawn from a cross section of students from batches 2011, 12, 13, and 14, erstwhile UCMS-SU office bearers, student coordinators of college societies, prominent alumni from 1975 to 2008, faculty, representatives of the college administration, and staff advisors to various students societies, were held on 9, 13, 16, and 20 April, 2015.

**The following consensus was arrived at:**

1. The best time for Students' Union Election is April. As April is going on, this year it has been decided to be held in May 2015 (preferably 10-20 May)
2. All the students are free to contest for any post.
3. The students' union should be expanded by introducing two representatives (one male and one female preferably) from each batch. Thus there will be an addition of 10 batch representatives which can be a part of the Executive Committee of the Students Union.
4. Those who have academic arrears cannot contest the elections. (As per Lyngdoh committee)
5. Even students short of attendance cannot contest the elections. As real time attendance is not available in UCMS as of now, the following alternative method was accepted. For the second semester students, attendance till 31st March of the same year in which the election is being held will be considered. If the attendance is not available from the respective departments, then the attendance till 31st Dec of the previous year (i.e. end of the semester) will be considered. For those students in the other semesters i.e. 4th, 6th, and 8th the students who have passed the last professional /supplementary examination held will be eligible to contest the elections as those students are only allowed to appear for the exams who have the required number of attendances.
6. The candidate should in no event have any academic arrears in the year of contesting the election. Any pending paper(s) will be construed as academic arrear(s). Candidates failed in the preceding academic year and/or re-admitted in the current academic year will not be eligible to contest the election.
7. In case an elected member of the students' union fails to clear the next examination, or is detained due to shortage of attendance during the tenure, he/she will be divested of his/her post for the remaining period In order to encourage him/her to devote more time to academic achievement.
8. The above may be construed as the nucleus of a written constitution of the UCMS-SU to be elaborated through stake-holder meetings from time to time.
