2. It shall be ensured by the College/concerned State Government that:

- Adequate funds are provided in Plan Budget regularly till all facilities are provided.
- 50% Seats are contributed to All India Quota (Except the Colleges in Andhra Pradesh, Telangana & Jammu & Kashmir)

3. This permission for starting/increase of seats in the above courses and admission of students will be till such time the first batch of students admitted against the above course (s) appears for the first final examination in the subject. The College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 11(2) of IMC Act at the time of first batch admitted against the course appears for final year examinations.

Sub: University of Delhi, Delhi - Recognition of MD(Anaesthesiology) qualification against increased intake from 08(Eight) to 12(Twelve) seat(s) in respect of students being trained at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi.

Sir,

It is stated that the assessment report (April, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi for purpose of Recognition of MD(Anaesthesiology) qualification against increased intake from 08(Eight) to 12(Twelve) seat(s) granted by University of Delhi, Delhi was considered by the Board of Governors at its meeting held on 24.07.2013 and it was decided as under:-

"The Board of Governors considered the assessment report (April, 2013) and noted that MD(Anaesthesiology) qualification is already recognized with 08(Eight) seat(s) and decided to recommend that MD(Anaesthesiology) qualification against increased intake from 08(Eight) to 12(Twelve) seat(s) granted by University of Delhi, Delhi in respect of students being trained at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 with the number of admissions to 12(Twelve) student(s) per year."

The Board of Governors further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause 4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.
