University of Delhi, Delhi - Recognition of MS(OBG) qualification against increased intake from 06 to 12 seats in respect of students being trained at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi.

Sir/ Madam,

I am to state that the General Body of this council at its meeting held on 22/11/2016 considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (04/04/2016) along with the Council Assessor's report (April, 2014 & 11.06.2015) and compliance dated 12/10/2015 submitted by the college authorities on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi for purpose of Recognition of MS(OBG) qualification against increased intake from 06 to 12 seats granted by University of Delhi, Delhi.

The Council approved the following recommendations of the Postgraduate Committee, which I am directed to convey herewith for your information and necessary action:-

"The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee considered the Compliance Verification Assessment Report (04/04/2016) along with the Council Assessor's Report (April, 2014 & 11.06.2015) and compliance dated 12/10/2015 submitted by the college authorities and decided to recommend to the Central Government that MS(OBG) qualification against increased intake from 06 to 12 seats granted by University of Delhi, Delhi in respect of students being trained at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Medical Education Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of Notification upon which the Institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the Postgraduate Course.".

Sir.

It is stated that the assessment report (April, 2012) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi for purpose of Recognition of MD/MS(OBG) in respect of increased intake from 4 to 6 seats & Recognition of DGO qualification granted by University of Delhi, Delhi was considered by the Board of Governors and it was decided as under:-

'The Board of Governors considered the assessment report (April, 2012) and noted that the matter of recognition of MD/MS(OBG) in respect of increased intake from 4 to 6 seats us 04(Four) seats already recognised & Recognition of DGO qualification and decided to:

- 1. Recommend that MD/MS(OBG) qualification against increased intake from 04(Four) to -06(Six) seat(s) granted by University of Delhi, Delhi in respect of students being trained at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Dolhi be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the LM.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 06(Six) student(s) per year.
- Recommend that DGO qualification granted by University of Delhi, Delhi in respect of students being trained at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 03(Three) student(s) per year."

The Board of Governors further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as unders-

- The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-cluase-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.

This Letter of Permission for enhancement of postgraduate seats as quoted above is granted till the first batch admitted against increased intake appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution is advised to apply through the affiliating university for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.
