University of Delhi, Delhi - Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) in respect of increased intake from 4 to 6 seats & recognition of DCH qualification in respect of students being trained at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi.

I am directed to state that the Board of Governors, Medical Council of India considered the assessment report (April, 2012) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi for Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification in respect of increased intake from 4 to 6 seats & recognition of DCH qualification granted to University of Delhi, Delhi and it was decided as under:-

"The Board of Governors considered the assessment report (April, 2012) and noted that the matter of recognition is for recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification in respect of increased intake from 4 to 6 seats as 04(Four) seats already recognized & recognition of DCH qualification and decided to:-

1. recommend that MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 04(Four) to 06(Six) seat(s) granted by University of Delhi, Delhi in respect of students being trained at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 06(Six) student(s) per year."
2. recommend that DCH qualification granted by University of Delhi, Delhi in respect of students being trained at University College of Medical Sciences & GTB Hospital, Delhi be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 03(Three) student(s) per year."

The attention of the institute is drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.

You are requested to issue notification recognizing the above qualification on or after April, 2012 for degree & diploma both.
